- Recommending ways to improve the delivery of service to clients.
- Assisting with staff member issues and concerns.
- Supporting staff members through the issue resolution and performance development processes.
- Facilitating collaboration at all levels of the organization by sharing local innovations.
- Planning local events that engage and recognize staff.
- Supporting SE Health's internal communications function and Saint Elizabeth Foundation by promoting organization-wide initiatives with local staff (as requested) and sharing local initiatives to profile across the organization.
- Liaising with Staff Associations across the province(s) to share best practices.
