What medications can I get prescribed?

Medications for certain minor conditions, such as UTIs, acne, skin rashes, and hemorrhoids, and more. The pharmacist has the right to decide if the prescription is appropriate for your condition.

What can I expect during my appointment?

Your pharmacist will assess your condition and decide the best course of action, whether that be to recommend an over-the-counter product, prescribe medication, or make a referral to another health care provider.

Will my pharmacist notify my doctor?

Pharmacists who prescribe medications are required to notify a patient's primary care provider to support continuity of care and treatment outcomes.
