Who benefits from our services?

Our staff provides services to individuals with many different needs, such as:

- People with physical disabilities or serious injuries who want to drive
- Individuals asked to have a driving assessment by their doctor or the Ministry of Transportation of Ontario (MTO)
- Drivers who would like to ensure they continue to be safe on the road
- People on medications or those with a medical conditions (i.e. dementia, stroke, multiple sclerosis) that may be affecting their ability to drive
- People with impaired vision such as blind spots, who do not meet MTO visual field standards and qualify for the Vision Waiver Program

- People who need modified driving equipment or special instruction
- Those with stress/anxiety issues specifically related to driving
- Individuals with a mental health condition such as depression or bi-polar disorder
- People who require a wheelchair accessible vehicle for use by a passenger with a disability

What services do we provide?

Our services include thorough Ministry-approved clinical assessment, on-road evaluations and training for clients with physical, cognitive or psychological disabilities affecting their driving.

- Prescriptions for adaptive devices and vehicle modifications that enable clients to drive safely
- DriveABLE™ – Cognitive driver assessments based on award-winning university research and approved by the MTO

- Driver rehabilitation training covering all aspects of driving with a disability
- Passenger evaluations for people who require a modified vehicle for transportation
- Functional Vision Waiver Assessments for people who don't meet MTO visual field standards
- Motorcycle and Bicycle Assessments
- Comprehensive written reports

Where can you access our services:

We have several locations across Ontario. Under specific circumstances, we also offer community-based driving assessments.

- **On-site Assessment**
 - Our offices are centrally located and easily accessible
- **Community Driver Assessment**
 - Please call to see if our on-road evaluations can be done in your community
- **Home Pick-Up**
 - Following the assessment, if rehabilitation is recommended, the driving instructor may pick up the client for training from their home or work location

How are the services funded?

Our services are not covered by OHIP; however, coverage may be available through extended health care benefit plans, Workplace Safety and Insurance Board (WSIB) or March of Dimes. We will help clients explore payment options and alternatives that work for them.

When is it time to contact us?

At times, people have difficulty recognizing a decline in their ability to drive. When these signs become noticeable, it may be time to undergo a fair and accurate driver assessment. Examples of concerns include:

- Frequent close calls on the road or in a parking lot
- Unaware of other vehicles
- Often angering other drivers, frequently honked at
- Unexplained vehicle damage
- Family members not comfortable riding in vehicle
